Please use the following information for completing the "Writing About Winter" assignments.

You will use the supplied paper to complete each assignment. One assignment will be completed for each day that you are home when school has been cancelled. Use a pencil. Use good writing, grammar and punctuation skills. You will be given a grade on each individual assignment. Please bring the assignments back to school with you once we return.

Snow Day #1

Pretend that you and your friends are going to build a life-sized snowperson. Make a list of items you will use to make its face, arms, and clothes. What name will you give it? Does your snowperson come to life like Frosty? What makes the magic happen? What personality does it have? Write about your friends are that you have chosen to help you make the snowman. How does you snowman look? What are some things that you think your snowman would like to do if he/she came to life? What are some questions that he/she would ask? Include a paragraph or two describing a day of adventure with your snow friend.

Snow Day #2

Take a few minutes to think back and reflect on some of your favorite winter memories. Write about one of your favorite memories that you have had. Why was it your favorite? What made it one of your favorite? Describe your memory in detail. Express your feelings and emotions in detail about your favorite memory.

Snow Day #3

Write as many words as you can about the Winter Season. Just start writing words but they have to be related to Winter itself. Example: If I told you to write as many words as you can about the Summer Season you may include words such as: Hot, Sunny, Lemonade, Beach, Swimming, Sunglasses etc. Just simply start writing words and write as many as you can.
